



What to Bring for Filing Your VA Claim

Disability Claim:

- ✓ Discharge; DD-214
- ✓ Marriage certificate (current marriage)
- ✓ Prior marital history (vet & spouse)
 - DD/MM/YYYY, place of marriage, name of whom married to, how marriage ended (death, divorce, etc.), DD/MM/YYYY, place of ending
- ✓ Birth certificates (dependent children), proof of school or disability if over age 18
- ✓ SSN's (vet & dependents)
- ✓ Medical diagnosis and evidence (SMR, PME)
- ✓ Direct deposit information



Pension Claim:

- ✓ Discharge; DD-214
- ✓ Marriage certificate (current marriage)
- ✓ Prior marital history (vet & spouse)
 - DD/MM/YYYY, place of marriage, name of whom married to, how marriage ended (death, divorce, etc.), DD/MM/YYYY, place of ending
- ✓ Death certificate (of veteran for survivors' pension)
- ✓ Birth certificates (dependent children), proof of school or disability if over age 18
- ✓ SSN's (vet & dependents)
- ✓ Income and asset information
- ✓ Out of pocket medical expenses
- ✓ Direct deposit information



Burial Claim:

- ✓ Discharge; DD-214
- ✓ Marriage certificate (if widow)
- ✓ Death Certificate of veteran
- ✓ Burial Expenses (PIF) if possible
